connected on an emotional level.

In unposed pictures, they're usually touching, even just at the elbow. There's often a wry smile – an indication of sharing a private joke. Their bodies are often in synchrony, which suggests a depth of maturity – the fact they've been through real ups and downs.

In posed images, their smiles are occasionally frozen, which signals a disconnection between what they're doing and what they're feeling, but there could be banks of cameras in front of them, and they have to remain dignified and gracious at all times.

In the engagement portrait, she's saying 'he's all mine and look at this ring'. It's a megawatt smile from her, relief from him. Overall, I see a lot of interplay, a lot of love, and I'd say they're very happy.
